Y3 Prehistoric activity day@ Mount Cook adventure centre - Friday 18th October 2024

To enhance our learning and allow children to get hands on with history, we will be spending the day being immersed into prehistoric life. During the day, children will be invited to become hunter gatherers and learn archery, explore artefacts that tells us what life was like back then and finally craft art tools to create cave art to tell their stories.

The children will need to arrive at school by 8:20am. We will be travelling by coach and aiming to return to school for 4:30pm depending on traffic. If there are any delays we will inform you through class dojo.

The total cost of the trip is £25. The school is subsiding the cost the lower it for parents.
